Flagging/Working

The flagging/work days for the 2017 year are set: Unadilla Pro race only August 12 and again this year SATRA will be working the Broome-Tioga Hare Scramble May 27 & 28th. The applications will have the work dates on them. Make sure to select your days on the application. That really helps in setting up the work days. Again this year: The work day requirements are 2 work days with one required to be flagging. Keep in mind that without our flagging and work commitments, we wouldn't be able to ride some of the tracks we do. If you can't meet the work requirements, you may join as a non-working member. This is an important commitment that the club makes to the tracks. If you sign-up for a work day and can't make it, you need to contact us and let us know as soon as possible. We do understand that unforeseen things can come up.

Membership

From now until May 31, 2017 the dues will be as follows: Sustaining - \$25 Single Working - \$120 Family Working - \$140 Non-Working Single/Family - \$375

<u>Starting June 1st 2018</u> all membership dues will be \$280 for the remaining 2017 riding season. If you meet the work requirements, i.e. flagging Unadilla or any other <u>pre-approved</u> work arrangements, you will be given a refund of the difference of a working membership (\$160 single, \$140 Family) at the end of the riding season.

<u>NEW THIS YEAR:</u> There will be a \$20 surcharge added to all membership dues for any membership paid at a ride. Please think ahead and sign up early.

Working family members over the age of 18 are expected to flag and non-working riding family members over the age of 18 are required to have their own membership.

Any questions in regards to the membership can be directed to Luke Schuon or Myself.

Renewals will be emailed this year and you should have received a renewal in addition to this newsletter. If you did not receive a renewal form for some reason, you can go to the website and download an application. Make sure to get your membership renewal in as soon as possible as it does take some time for Luke to process the data and send you a membership card. Remember to bring your membership card to every ride. Memberships and renewals are not accepted at rides unless you have made prior arrangements with an officer. If you do make prior arrangements you must pay in cash at the ride and there will be a \$20 surcharge added to the yearly dues. We are always looking to recruit new members. Talk to friends who are interested in riding. But keep in mind; it is important that you are up front with any potential new member, by clearly explaining the required workday policy of the club. (2 workdays of which 1 must be Flagging) SATRA is one of the best bargains around, in terms of the number of ride days for the cost

The first ride of the year is right around the corner, remember to call the SATRA hotline before any rides or meetings for any last minute updates.
